Personal History

Arthur Edward ARNETT was born at Wakefield, Yorkshire in 1896 the son of Fred and Annie ARNETT nee COCKELL who were married 1893 at Wakefield, Yorkshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 13, Dentstone Street, Wakefield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 7, Birkhill Street, Sandal Magna, Wakefield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 4

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

Service History

He was living at Accrington, Sation House when he enlisted in the York and Lancaster Regiment at Barnsley.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 September 1917 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
