Personal History

John COMMONS was born at Rochdale, Lancashire in 1889.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Julia COMMONS (nee MAGUIRE) They married at Rochdale Register Office or Registrar Attended on 26 March 1905. They had children: Josephine b. 1913
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Rochdale as an Extra Checker

Service History

He was living at Rochdale. Lancashire when he enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at the same place. and embarked for France on 18 July 1915. His last known address was Rochdale, Whitehall Street, 37 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 12 August 1916 aged 26 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
