Personal History

Ernest COOKE was born at Penwortham, Lancashire in 1892 the son of Thomas and Elizabeth COOKE nee PHILIPS who were married 1882 at St. Andrew, Ashton on Ribble. His mother died in 1925.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 9, Lostock Square, Walton-Le-Dale,. He was aged 8

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Wyre as a Shunter

Service History

He enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Blackburn, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 29 November 1914. His last known address was Walton (le-Dale, Lostock Square, 9 - 1901 Census). He is recorded as Died at home on 31 August 1918 aged 26

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
