Personal History

Dominic COSTA was born at Southport, Lancashire in 1890 the son of John and Eliza COSTA nee THACKERY who were married 1880 at Blackburn Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at 8, Grove Street, Birkdale, Southport,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Firewood Carter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 7, Fisher Road, Southport,. He was aged 10

In the 1891 census the family were living at 1. Fisher Road, Southport,. He was aged 4 Months

He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary Ellen COSTA (nee DAVIES) They married at Ormskirk Register Office or Registrar Attended on 25 March 1905. They had children: Doris Winfred b. 1912, Nora b. 1914, Mary b. 1917

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Fitters Assistant

Service History

He was living at Southport, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at the same place. and embarked for France on 5 August 1915. His last known address was Southport, Birkdale, Grove Street, 8 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 14 April 1918 aged 28

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal, 1914-15 Star & Military Medal
