Personal History

Mark COUPS was born at St. George, Manchester in 1895 the son of Christopher D. and Julietta COUPS nee TRESS who were married 1895 at Manchester Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1950. His mother died in 1950.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 17, Smeaton Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Butchers Apprentice.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 13, Smeaton Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locootive Dept. at Horwich as a Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 15 June 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Horwich, Ainsworth Avenue, 55 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 10 August 1915 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
