Personal History

Thomas Barnes COWPE was born at Fleetwood, Lancashire in 1898 the son of Richard and Marjory COWPE nee FAIRCLOUGH who were married 18/05/1898 at St. Peter, Fleetwood. His father died in 1945. His mother died in 1945.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 18, Kemp Street, Fleetwood, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar and Newsboy.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 67. Adelaide Street, Fleetwood, Lancashire. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Fleetwood, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died on 2 January 1919 in Mesopotamia aged 21

He was awarded the British War Medal
