*Died of Wounds 18 August 1915 aged 27*

***Personal History***

*Albert CRADDOCK was born at Bedale, Yorkshire in 1888 the son of Tobias and Isabella CRADDOCK nee RAPER who were married 29/12/1883 at St. Mary, Masham, Claro, Yorkshire. His father died in 1907. His mother died in 1907.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at Clifton Bedale, Yorkshire,. He was aged 13*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at Clifton Cott. He was aged with the occupation of Age 3.*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Hoghton as a Porter*

***Service History***

*He was living at Bedale, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Blackburn, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 1 August 1915. His last known address was Bedale, Clifton, Yorkshire (1901 Census).*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 18 August 1915 in Gallipoli aged 27*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
