Personal History

Archibald Edward CREASER was born at Doncaster, Yorkshire in 1885 the son of Francis and Harriet CREASER nee ADAMSON who were married 12/09/1880 at Chridt Church, Doncaster, Yorkshire. His father died in 1946. His mother died in 1946.

In the 1911 census the family were living at "Emden", Goole Docks,. He was aged 25 with the occupation of 2nd Mate.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 15, Highfield Road, Wheatley, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Body Builer Apprentice.

In the 1891 census the family were living at St. Mary's Road, Wheatley, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5 He was a married man. His wife's name was Eva CREASER (nee BRAHAM)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company
