*Killed in action 28 March 1918 aged 29*

***Personal History***

*James CROOKS was born at Kirkdale, Liverpool in 1888 the son of Robert and Margaret CROOKS nee ROBERTS.*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Annie CROOKS (nee DONNELLY)*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Oldham as a Shunter*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Seaforth, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 19 May 1915. His last known address was Liverpool, Clement Street, 46 (1911 Census).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 March 1918 aged 29*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
