Personal History

James CROOKS was born at Kirkdale, Liverpool in 1888 the son of Robert and Margaret CROOKS nee ROBERTS.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Annie CROOKS (nee DONNELLY)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Oldham as a Shunter

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Seaforth, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 19 May 1915. His last known address was Liverpool, Clement Street, 46 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 March 1918 aged 29

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
