Arthur Moulter CROSS was born at Darwen, Lancashire in 1895 the son of Joseph and Sarah CROSS nee TOWNLEY who were married 1883 at Blackburn Register Office or Registrar Attended . His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at 193, Lambeth Streert, Blackburn,. He was aged 17m Carpenter and Joiner

In the 1901 census the family were living at 207, Pringle Street, Blackburn,. He was aged 7

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He is recorded as Died on 29 July 1918 aged 23
