Personal History

Albert Joseph CROWE was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1896 the son of Joseph Airey and Elizabeth J. CROWE nee BUGGIONE who were married 1892 at St. John, Bootle, Liverpool. His father died in 1947. His mother died in 1947.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 41, Orwell Road, Kirkdale, Liverpool,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Brass Finishing Apprentice.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 20, Orwell Road, Kirkdale, Liverpool,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Joint Porter

Service History

He was living at Kirkdale, Liverpool when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire at Liverpool, Lancashire. on 10 December 1915

He is recorded as Killed in action on 25 April 1918 aged 22 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
