Personal History

Edward CULSHAW was born at Halsall, Ormskirk, Lancashire in 1887 the son of James and Ann CULSHAW nee CAVE who were married 18/05/1863 at St. Thomas, Halsall, Ormskirk. His father died in 1903. His mother died in 1903.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Hasall Hall, Hassall, Ormskirk,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Farm Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Plex Lane, Halsall, Ormskirk,. He was aged 14

In the 1891 census the family were living at Plex Lane, Halsall, Ormskirk,. He was aged 4

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Fazakerley as a Signaller

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Southport, Lancashire. on 7 September 1914 and embarked for France on 27 July 1915. His last known address was Halsall, Hasall Hill (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 September 1916 aged 29

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
