Personal History

Thomas CUTTER was born at Kessingland, Lowestoft in 1865 the son of Charles and Eliza CUTTER nee UTTING. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at Vessel "Bertha", Port of Goole,. He was aged 44 with the occupation of Master.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Vessel "Marjorie", 2nd Mate,. He was aged 35 He was a married man. His wife's name was Priscilla CUTTER (nee NICHOLLS) They married at Kessingland Parish Church, Lowestoft on 25 December 1890

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company
