He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary Marjorie ASHWORTH (nee HALL) They married at United Reform Church, Rochdale Road, Bury on 28 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Irlam O'Th Hts as a Brakesman

Service History

He enlisted in the Yorkshire Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 5 October 1914.

He is recorded as Died at home on 11 October 1917 in Cameron Hospital, West Hartlepool He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
