*John ASHWORTH was born at Broughton, Manchester.*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary Marjorie ASHWORTH (nee HALL) They married at United Reform Church, Rochdale Road, Bury on 28 March 1905*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Irlam O'Th Hts as a Brakesman*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Yorkshire Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 5 October 1914.*

*He is recorded as Died at home on 11 October 1917 in Cameron Hospital, West Hartlepool*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star*
