Personal History

Thomas DANIELS was born at Manchester, Lancashire in 1894 the son of Thomas and Sarah Ann DANIELS nee HARDMAN. His mother died in 1939.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Silver Street, Miles Platting, Manchester,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Checker for Railway Co..

In the 1901 census the family were living at 43, Pir Street, Miles Platting, Manchester,. He was aged 6

He was a married man. His wife's name was Ellen DANIELS (nee ASHWORTH) They married at Barton-upon-Irwell Registry Office or Registrar Atended on 30 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dpt. at Oldham as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for 2B on 17 October 1915. His last known address was Manchester, Oldham Road, Winstanley Street, 16 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 16 August 1917 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
