Personal History

Francis Evan DAVENPORT was born at Freetown, Bury, Lancashire in 1887 the son of Evan and Elizabeth DAVENPORT nee DAVENPORT who were married 29/08/1874 at St. Paul, Bury, Lancashire. His father died in 1917. His mother died in 1917.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 1, Naysmyth Street, Horwicj, Lancashire,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Construction Engineer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 543, Chorley New Road, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Apprentice Boilermaker.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 128, Wright Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 4 with the occupation of Scholar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Ellen DAVENPORT (nee LOVETT) They married at Holy Trinity, Horwich, Lancashire on 26 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Plater

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 27 September 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Naysmith Street, 1 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 22 August 1916 in 21st Casualty Clearing Station - France aged 29 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
