Personal History

Thomas D DAVIDSON was born at Chester-Le-Street on 26 June 1895 the son of Robert James and Margaret DAVIDSON nee HURWORTH who were married 1896 at Chester-Le-Street, Durham. His mother died in 1943.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 18, Lambton Street, Chester-Le-Street, Durham,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Apprentice to Grocer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 24, Albert Street, Chester-Le-Street, Durham,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Manchester (Station) as a Train Booker

He enlisted in the Royal Marines.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 June 1915 aged 19
