Charles DAWSON was born at Dewsbury, Yorkshire on 7 June 1898 the son of Thomas and Martha Ann DAWSON nee DENTON who were married 17/01/1886 at St. John the Evangalst, Dewsbury Moor, Yorkshire. His father died in 1933. His mother died in 1933.
