William Norton DEAN was born at Ardwick, Manchester in 1895 the son of William and Bertha DEAN nee CHEETHAM who were married 1892 at St. Thomas, Ardwick, Manchester. His mother died in 1929. Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept, at Newton Heath Shops as an Apprentice Wagon Maker
