Personal History

Alfred DEARDEN was born at Haslingden, Preston in 1893 the son of Adam and Sarah DEARDEN nee SHAW who were married 03/03/1882 at All Saints, Elton, Lancashire. His father died in 1932. His mother died in 1932.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 139, Newchurch Road, Bacup,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 19, Equitable Street, Milnrow, Lancashire,. He was aged 8 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

He enlisted in the Royal Garrison Artillery.

He is recorded as Died at home on 3 June 1919 in Hospital, Home aged 26 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
