Personal History

John DING was born at Coveney, Cambridgeshire in 1876 the son of John Thomas and Sarah Jane DING nee GIDDENS who were married 1880 at Ely, Cambridgeshire. His father died in 1933. His mother died in 1933.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 9, Sydney Road, Byfleet,. He was aged 33 with the occupation of Shunter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Street, Coveney,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Farm Labourer.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Ada Katurak DING (nee WILLIAMS) They married at Hereford, Herefordshire on 20 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendant of the Line at Crofton Junction as a Reserve Shunter

Service History

He enlisted in the Northamptonshire Infantry at Peterborough. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 13 August 1914. His last known address was Byfield. Sidney Road, 9 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 14 September 1914 aged 36

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
