Personal History

Thomas DOLAN was born at Oldham, Lancashire in 1890 the son of John and Catherine DOLAN nee MALONEY. His father died in 1936. His mother died in 1936.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 28, Evelyn Street, Oldham, Lancashire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Railway Shunter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 29, Gordon Street, Oldham, Lancashire,. He was aged 11 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 11, Grove Street, Oldham, Lancashire,. He was aged 1 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Oldham (Mumps) as a Shunter

Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Oldham, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 11 July 1915. His last known address was Oldham, Evelyn Street, 28 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 26 September 1916 aged 26

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
