Personal History

John Henry Bradshaw DRIVER was born at Horbury, Yorkshire in 1896 the son of John Henry and Sarah A. DRIVER nee COOK.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 30, Brown Lodge Street, Smithy Bridge, Rochdale.. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Cotton Picker Shop Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at GardenSquare, Horbury, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5 (wth Grandparents)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Smithy Bridge as a Chargemans Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Rochdale, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 October 1917 aged 20 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
