Personal History

Myers DUBBIN was born at Blackburn, Lancashire in 1886 the son of Thomas and Alice DUBBIN nee HORNBY who were married 1875 at St. Michael with St. John and Holy Trinity, Blackburn. His father died in 1939. His mother died in 1939.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 65, Ingham Street, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Railway Plumbers Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 59, Ingham Street, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Cotton Cloth Hawker.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 59, Ingham Street, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer

He enlisted in the Machine Gun Corps at Blackburn, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 March 1918 aged 31

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
