Personal History

Thomas ASPINALL was born at Hollinwood, Oldham, Lancashire in 1884 the son of George and Mary Ann ASPINALL nee STUCKBURY who were married 25/08/1883 at St. Peter, Oldham, Lancashire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 60, Wesley Street, Failsworth, Lancashire,. He was aged 26 with the occupation of Iron Moulder.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Elizabeth Ann ASPINALL (nee BERRY) They married at Wesleyan Methodist Chapel, Oldham Road, Failsworth on 29 August 1908. They had children: Clifford b. 1909, Arthur b.1912, Thomas Berry b. 1914

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Failsworth as a Porter

Service History

He was living at Mc/r, East Failsworth, Ashton Road, 90. when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Oldham, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 21 April 1915. His last known address was Failsworth, Wesley Street, 60 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 18 November 1916 aged 32

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
