Personal History

William Henry L DUCKER was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1893 the son of Mary Elizabeth L DUCKER. In the 1911 census the family were living at 61, Parliament Strteet, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 7 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 10 September 1915. His last known address was Goole, Parliament Street, 60 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 2 February 1916 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
