Personal History

Joseph DUDDY was born at Marple, Cheshire on 20 May 1885 the son of Thomas and Mary DUDDY nee NAVEN who were married 1875 at Hayfield, Derbyshire. His father died on .

In the 1891 census the family were living at Marple Bridge, Derbyshire,. He was aged 4 with the occupation of Nephew of James and Brigett Naven.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civi Engineers Dept. at Low Moor as a Ballastman

Service History

He enlisted in the Cheshire Regiment at Macclesfield, Cheshire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 16 August 1914. His last known address was Marple, Church Lane, Poplar Square, Sister Catherine He is recorded as Died on 4 December 1917 in Mexhede, Germany, P.O.W. aged 32 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
