Frank DUNLOP was born at Chorley, Lancashire in 1898 the son of George James and Alice DUNLOP nee GRIME who were married 27/02/1892 at St. George, Chorley. His father died in 1940. His mother died in 1940.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 22. Red Bank, Chorley, Lancashire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Labourer at Rope and Twine Works.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Holms Barn, Chorley, Lancashire,. He was aged 3

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich

He was living at Chorley, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died in At Sea aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
