Personal History

William EASTON was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of Elizabeth EASTON.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 19, George Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 13, George Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 4

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 17 August 1915. His last known address was Goole, George Street, 19 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 15 September 1916 in 34th Casualty Clearing Station aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
