## Personal History

Ronald EASTWOOD was born at Birkdale, Lancashire in 1889 the son of Peter and Emily EASTWOOD nee SHEPHERD who were married 1883 at St. James, Birkdale. His father died in 1935. His mother died in 1935. In the 1911 census the family were living at 52, Wstbourne Road, Birkdale, Southport,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Pupil to Civil Eng. On Railway.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 25, Crossley Road, Birkdale, Southport.. He was aged 11 In the 1891 census the family were living at 2, Liverpool Road, Birkdale, Southport,. He was aged 1 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Engineers Head Office as an Engineering Assistant

## Service History

He enlisted in the East Lancashire Royal Engineers. and embarked for France on 12 September 1915. His last known address was Birkdale, Westbourne Road, 52 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 5 December 1917 aged 28

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
