Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He enlisted in the Royal Garrison Artillery at Manchester, Lancashire. on 3 December 1915 He is recorded as Died at home on 11 December 1918 in Victoria Hospital, Stretford aged 33
