Personal History

John Thomas ECCLES was born at Chipping, Lancashire in 1894 the son of James and Ann ECCLES nee MERCER who were married 1892 at St. Bartholomew, Chipping. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 72, Sharoe Green ane, Fulwood, Preston,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Agricultural Student.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Hesketh Row, Chipping,. He was aged 7

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Andsell as a Summer Porter

Service History

He was living at Chipping, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Preston, Lancashire, on 8 December 1915

He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 April 1917 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
