Personal History

John William ATHERTON was born at Lower Ince, Wigan, Lancashire in 1893 the son of William and Harriet ATHERTON nee FARRIMOLD.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Howich as a Labourer

Service History

He was living at Wigan, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Royal Munster Fusiliers at the same place. He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 13 May 1916 aged 23
