Personal History

Richard EDWARDS was born at Bootle, Liverpool, Lancashire in 1893 the son of Richard and Mary Edith EDWARDS nee HARDY who were married 1886 at St. Mary, Walton. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 12, Hamer Terrace, Bootle, Liverpool,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Crane Lad.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 1, Cyprus Road, Bootle, Liverpoool,. He was aged 7 (Living as Stepson)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Shunter

He was living at Bootle, Liverpool, Lanacashire when he enlisted in the Royal Engineers at Liverpool, Lancashire, on 27 November 1915

He is recorded as Died on 12 October 1917 in Pnuemonia, Queen Alexander Hosp. aged 24 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
