In the 1911 census the family were living at 91. Teulon Street, Kirkdale, Liverpool,. He was aged 13 In the 1901 census the family were living at 60. Thomaston Street, Kirkdale, Liverpool,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Capstanman

He enlisted in the Machine Gun Corps at Liverpool, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died on 4 June 1918 in P.O.W. Camp - Germany aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
