Personal History

Edmund ELLERSHAW was born at Giggleswick, Yorkshire in 1889.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Church Street, Giggleswick,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of General Midlsnd Railway Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Castle Hill, Settle,. He was aged 11

In the 1891 census the family were living at 31, Victoria Square, Settle,. He was aged 1 with the occupation of (Stepson).

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Nelson as a Carter

Service History

He was living at Longpreston, Lancashire when he enlisted in the West Riding Regiment at Settle. on 22 May 1912 and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 14 April 1915. His last known address was Nelson, Sackville Street, 66 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 July 1916 aged 26

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
