Personal History

Sidney ELSE was born at Whittington, Derbyshire in 1879 the son of Fred and Maria ELSE nee HALFORD who were married 16/01/1899 at Whittington. His father died in 1954. His mother died in 1954.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 5, West Street, Goldthorpe, Rotherham, Derbyshire,. He was aged 11

In the 1901 census the family were living at 18, Victoria Road, Old Whittington, Whittington, Chesterfield, Derbyshire,. He was aged 1

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Chargeman's Labourer

Service History

He was living at Goldthorpe, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the Yorkshire Hussars at Mexborough, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 13 April 1918 aged 18

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
