Personal History

Frank ENGLAND was born at Knottingley, Yorkshire in 1879 the son of John and Annie Lister ENGLAND nee STEPHENSON who were married 08/01/1865 at St. Peter, Bradford, Yorkshire. His father died in 1932. His mother died in 1932.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 26, Dean Lane, Moston, Manchester,. He was aged 31 with the occupation of Railway Booking Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 225, Lightbowne Roasd, Prestwich, Manchester,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Railway Booking Clerk.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Manchester (Booking Office) as a Booking Clerk

Service History

He was living at South Milford, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 16 July 1915. His last known address was South Milfor, Yorkshire, Sherburn (in-Elmet, Highfield Villas, 80 - CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 July 1916 aged 36

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
