Personal History

Robert William ENGLAND was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1883 the son of John William and Eliza ENGLAND nee AXUP who were married 01/07/1876 at St. Laurence, Snaith. His father died in 1930. His mother died in 1930.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 5, Providence Place, Hook Road, Goole. He was aged 30 with the occupation of Dock Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 5, Providence Place, Hook Road, Goole. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Dock Labourer.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 11, St. Marks Trrace, Hook, ?Goole,. He was aged 8 He was a married man. His wife's name was Annie Mary ENGLAND (nee MAW) They married at Goole Parish Church on 2 March 1901. They had children: George Ernest b. 1901, Albert b. 1904. Ada Lavinia b. 1906, Lily b. 1909

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Goole Steam Shipping at Goole as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the Norhumberland Fusiliers at London. and embarked for France on 19 December 1914. His last known address was Goole, Axholme Street, 5 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 22 August 1918 aged 36

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
