***Personal History***

*John FAULKNER was born at Manchester, Lancashire on 8 April 1886 the son of John and Sarah Jane FAULKNER nee SPENCE who were married 1882 at St. Clement, Salford. His father died in 1927. His mother died in 1927.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 42, Russell Street, Hulme. Manchester,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Railway Rope Splicer.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 4, Cobden Street. Manchester,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Warehouse Boy.*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 17, Bright Street, Hulme, Manchester,. He was aged 3*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Adelaide FAULKNER (nee SHAW) They married at St. Gabriel, Hulme, Manchester on 19 November 1910*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. Salford as a Rope Splicer*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Navy. on 9 June 1904*

*He is recorded as Died at home on 13 October 1918 in Cline House Military Hosp. Old Traff. aged 31*
