Personal History

Alexander FERGUSON was born at Dublin, Ireland in 1891.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Longmoor Camp, Grantham, Hampshire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Private Seaforth Highlanders.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the Seaforth Highlanders at Edinburgh, Scotland. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 23 August 1914.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 12 October 1917 aged 26

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star
