*Harry FERRIDAY was born at Donnington, Salop in 1889 the son of William and Emily FERRIDAY. His father died on .*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at Wharf Road, Gnosall Heath, Stafford,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 11, Wharton Street, Ordsall, Retford, Nottinghamshire,. He was aged 13*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at Wood Street, Heath Town Wednesfield,. He was aged 2*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Alice May FERRIDAY (nee WEBB) They married at Newport on 30 March 1905*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Engineers.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 22 February 1919 in 54th Casualty Clearing Station, France aged 30*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
