John Bevan FIELDEN was born at Hayfield, Derbyshire in 1899 the son of John Bevan and Sarah Ann FIELDEN nee GOODWIN who were married 1891 at Prestwich Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died on .

In the 1901 census the family were living at Pack Horse, High Street, Hayfield, Derbyshire,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter and Reserve Shunter

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 29 April 1918 aged 19
