Personal History

John Jeffery FILLINGHAM was born at Doncaster, Yorkshire in 1898 the son of John and Harriet FILLINGHAM nee JEFFERY who were married 1888 at St. Leonards and St. Mary, Armthorpe, Doncaster. His father died in 1934. His mother died in 1934.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 197, Alfred Road, Sheffield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 13

In the 1901 census the family were living at 29, Ellertree Avenue, Doncaster, Yorkshire,. He was aged 3

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer

Service History

He was living at Sheffield, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the York and Lancaster Regiment at Rotherham, Yorkshire. on 10 March 1914 and embarked for France on 9 February 1915. His last known address was Shipley, Thompson Street, 50 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 9 August 1915 aged 17

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
