Personal History

Harold FINCH was born at Parbold, Lancashire on 6 February 1898 the son of Alice FINCH nee Butler. His mother died in 1900.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 20, New Brunswick Street, Horwich,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Box Carrier at Cotton Bleachworks.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Bithfield, Wighton, Parbold, Lancashire,. He was aged 3

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the Border Regiment at Horwich, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 10 July 1917 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
