Personal History

William FISHER was born at Ancoats, Manchester in 1896 the son of Albert E and Sarah Ellen FISHER nee WILKINSON who were married 02/01/1888 at All Saints, Marple, Cheshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 30, Aqueduct Street, Ancoats, Manchester,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Errand Boy & Part Time Student.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 18, Aqueduct Street. Ancoats , Manchester. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Red Bank as a Globe Cleaner

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Army Medical Corps at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 11 August 1915. His last known address was Manchester, Ancoats, Aqueduct Street, 30 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died at sea on 13 August 1915 in Lost in Royal Edward aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
