Personal History

Edward FITZPATRICK was born at Manchester, Lancashire the son of John and Catherine FITZPATRICK nee TURNER who were married 1885 at Manchester Register Office or Registrar Attended. His mother died in 1922.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 7, Ebenezer Place, Red Bank, Manchester,. He was aged 15 In the 1901 census the family were living at 2, Twemlon Street, Manchester,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Restaurant Car Attendant

Service History

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 23 July 1916 aged 21 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
