William FITZPATRICK was born at Bury, Lancashire the son of Joseph and Alice Ann FITZPATRICK nee ROBINSON who were married 1895 at Bury Register Office or Registrar Attended. His mother died in 1924. In the 1911 census the family were living at 13, Bright Street, Bury,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Warehouse Boy.
